Basic Characteristic

Czech Cup 2023 is all-season competition in road cycling dedicated to Men Elite and Men U23 category. Junior riders, who are part of junior national team for 2023 can participate. Other Junior riders can participate only with written agreement by their national coach and in condition there is no Czech Cup for Junior category in the same date.

In case of full capacity of the race, preference will be given to the riders of Elite and U23 category.

The competition is consist of 7 road races. All races are counted to overall ranking of Czech Cup. The lenght of each race is set from 160 km to 200 km. In case of two consecutive race days, the Saturday race may be shortened to minimum lenght of 130 km if the profile of the race is tought.

Common provisions:

Participation:

Czech Cup races, excluding V4 race

The condition for participation is a valid license for 2023. MEN ELITE and MEN U23 riders can participate, and all categories start together.

According to the article of the regulations and the CCF road S0113, continental UCI teams registered with the ČSC, regional and club teams, national selections and mixed teams are allowed to participate. UCI WorldTeam and UCI ProTeam riders can compete only in the national selection team.

In addition, UCI continental teams from border countries (Germany, Austria, Poland, Slovakia) can also compete under the following conditions:

1. must apply to the CCF for permission to start at Czech Cup
2. can start with the number of 1 - 6 riders
3. the same rules apply to them as to the teams registered with the CCF (starting fee, etc.)

Registrations:

Registrations for each Czech Cup race is only possible via <https://csc.sportsoft.cz>

The deadline for registrations is set on Thursday at 12:00 in the week of the race.

Due to the limit of the maximum number of starters to 176 riders, preference will be given to riders with a Czech license. Foreign teams will complete the starting field to the number of 176 according to the date of registrations. On-site registrations is not accepted.

Teams that do not fit on the starting list will be informed by the organizer no later than 48 hours before the start of the race via email.

Registrations and entry fee for V4 race is set by UCI regulations. Registration forms should be send to: edr@ceskysvazcyklistiky.cz

Payment and entry fee:

Amount of on-line payment is 500 CZK. On-site payment is not accepted.

Meeting:

The meeting must take place at the specified time, always at least 90 minutes before the start of the race.

Time limit:

The time limit for each race will be indicated in the race schedule or announced by the PCP at the meeting.

Classification:

Categories of classification: overall standing of Czech Cup, Best U23 rider, Best newbie rider.

Individual classification:

For placing in each race, the following point rating is included in the overall rating:

In case of the same placing in overall standings of several riders, the better placing of the rider in the last race of the series will decide.

If this rule won't decide, the better position of the club in the last race of the series will decide.

Team classification:

The points earned by the 3 best riders of each club in the individual races of the series are included in this competition, by simply sum of the points earned from the race.

In case of the same point gain of several clubs, the better position of the club in the last race of the series will decide.

If even this rule won't decide, the better position of the best competitor of the club in the last race of the series will decide.

Foreign riders:

Foreign riders who do not compete for teams registered at CCF will take prize money and points and the final ranking will stay without any changes.

However, these riders will not figure in the final standings of Škoda Cup 2023 - Czech Cup in road cycling.

Prize money for each race:

The prize money will be paid after sending complete application, which is part of this schedule (annex 2 and 3). Duly completed and legible application must be delivered to the race office as soon as possible after the end of each race. Prize money will be paid immediately after the end of the race, after submitting a completed application only in cash.

In case, that U23 rider or younger will place to the 10th place, he will entitled to the reward for the overall ranking in the race as well as the reward for placing in the U23 category.

The prize money at the V4 race will be paid according to the UCI regulation 1.2 for 2023. The prize money will be paid by the organizer.

Start numbers, chips:

After finishing the race, each rider have to return the start numbers and chips to the race office. A fee of 3,000,- CZK will be charged for the loss or damage of the chip,

Order of mechanical vehicles:

Regulations for the first race of the series:

In case of the start of the current champion of the Czech Cup 2022, his team will be assigned mechanical car number 1. In the case of the start of the national selection team, it will be assigned mechanical car number 2.

Furthermore, up to the number of the first 10 vehicles according to the final order of the Czech Cup 2022 in the individual competition (club membership in the 2022 season is decided).

In the case of the participation of foreign UCI teams, the first vehicle of the foreign team will be in 5th place, the next in 8th place, etc. until the completion of the first 10 cars of the Czech teams. The order of foreign teams will be determined based on the UCI ranking of each team in the 2022 season.

The other teams will be drawn.

Other races of the Czech Cup:

The first 10 teams according to the reduced standings of the individual competition are guaranteed a mechanical car.

In the case of the participation of foreign UCI teams, the first vehicle of the foreign team will be in 5th place, the next in 8th place, etc. until the completion of the first 10 cars of the Czech teams. The order of foreign teams will be determined based on the UCI ranking of each team in the 2023 season.
